**Alameda Street/Oakland Waterfront Trail
(\$200,000)***

Consideration of a \$200,000 construction grant request from the City of Oakland for completion of 0.2 miles of Bay Trail along the Estuary and 0.42 miles of bike lanes on Alameda Avenue.

8th Street Bay Trail in Oakland (\$200,000)*

Huo

Consideration of a \$200,000 construction grant request from the City of Oakland for the completion of approximately 0.2 miles of bike lanes, sidewalks and landscaping along 8th Street between Willow and Wood, Wood between 7th and 8th and Mandela Parkway between 7th and 8th.

**Wildcat Creek Trail, 23rd Street to Davis Park
(\$500,000)***

Consideration of a \$500,000 planning/construction grant request from the City of San Pablo for the completion of approximately 850 linear feet of trail along the edge of Wildcat Creek between 23rd Street and Davis Park.

Carquinez Scenic Drive Bay Trail Studies (\$50,000)*

Consideration of a \$50,000 planning grant request from the Contra Costa County Public Works Department for two studies along the Carquinez Scenic Drive corridor - Biological Assessment/Wetlands Delineation and Historic Property Survey.

**Sears Point Restoration Public Access Study
(\$100,000)***

Consideration of a \$100,000 planning grant request from the Sonoma Land Trust to develop concepts for bicycle and pedestrian access, overall trail placement, rail line crossings and setbacks, new levee configuration, preliminary engineering and geotechnical analysis, location of staging areas and signage along a 2.5-mile section of new Bay Trail.
