Consider three new grant requests:

Interpretive Sign Plan for WW II Home Front Sites and Fabrication of Signs (\$100,000)

McBride

The Western Office of the National Trust for Historic Preservation seeks a planning grant to develop an integrated interpretive sign plan for WW II Home Front sites along and near the Bay Trail; & to design & fabricate a limited number of prototype signs.

Alviso Cannery Spur Trail (\$225,000)

Barry

Santa Clara Valley Water District proposes to construct approx. 200 feet of Bay Trail spine, an education center/gazebo, landscaping and interpretive signs adjacent to Alviso Marina County Park.

Gold Street Bridge Education Center (\$125,000)

Barry

Santa Clara Valley Water District proposes to construct 200 ft. of trail and an education center center along the south bank of the Guadalupe River and to install landscaping and a new parking lot.
