Wildlife and Public Access Study Report

Dr. Lynne Trulio

Background. In 1996 the Bay Trail Project commissioned an investigation into the impacts of recreational trails on wildlife. The work began with a review of the scientific literature review and the development of a research plan. The purpose of the research is to generate quantitative and statistically testable data on the impacts of typical trail users on saltmarsh birds.
