Subject: **Authorization to Submit a Grant Application to the California Department of Water Resources for the San Francisco Bay Region IRWM Prop 84 2015 Implementation Projects: "Bay Regional Climate Change Preparedness Program"**

## Executive Summary

In response to state statutes, the San Francisco Bay Integrated Regional Water Management Plan was developed to encourage integrated regional strategies for management of water resources and to provide funding for implementation projects that support the plan. The ABAG Executive Board adopted the Plan by Resolution No. 11-06 dated November 16, 2006 and the Revised IRWMP Plan by Resolution No. 04-14 dated March 20, 2014.

San Francisco Bay Area water, wastewater, flood protection and stormwater management agencies; cities and counties; watershed management interests, planning agencies and organizations, and non-governmental organizations are involved in the Bay Area IRWMP. They voluntarily participate in the Coordinating Committee (CC), which is the Regional Water Management Group for the Bay Area IRWMP. The Coordinating Committee selected the Association of Bay Area Governments/San Francisco Estuary Partnership to be the Applicant for the proposal for IRWMP Proposition 84 2015 Funding. The region is seeking \$41.3 million for projects in this round, the final round of implementation funding under Prop 84.

ABAG procured a consultant, Horizon Water and Environment, to write the grant application which is due to DWR on August 7, 2015. Agencies and organizations with projects in the application will pay the cost of the consultant, \$120,000.

The CC selected the projects listed on the following page to respond to the 2015 Guidelines. As part of the application, DWR requires a Resolution from the ABAG Executive Board designating an authorized representative to submit the application and execute a grant agreement with the State of California.

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Recommended Action

The Executive Board is requested to adopt Resolution No. 05-15 designating an authorized representative to submit the application and execute a grant agreement with the State of California for the San Francisco Bay Region IRWM Prop 84 Round 2 Implementation Projects.
