Hello Everyone,

Thank you for taking the time to chat with us on Thursday morning.

To recap our conversation, CalPERS' understanding is that ABAG will separate it's active employees and they will be re-hired by MTC. ABAG will continue to exist as its own entity, with a governing body, and retain its retiree population. Given this information, CalPERS would not terminate ABAG's participation under the Public Employees' Medical and Hospital Care Act (PEMHCA). The current health resolution would remain in effect and ABAG retirees would retain their health eligibility. Should ABAG's status change in the future (dissolves or merges into another entity), then we would need to have another discussion.

I hope this clarifies ABAG's participation under PEMHCA. Please let me know if you have any additional questions regarding this matter.
