Announced that he recently visited former Board chair Brian Wiese who is enjoying retirement in Washington State.

Informed the Board that he intends to nominate Maggie Wenger of BCDC staff to serve as his alternate on the Board of Directors and the Steering Committee. A formal vote will be conducted at the next full Board meeting.

City of Richmond Goodrick Avenue Design (\$63,000)

Thompson provided an overview of the grant program and allocations to date.

Huo provided an overview of the \$63,000 grant application submitted by the City of Richmond to complete design and construction documents for a 0.4-mile section of trail along Goodrick Avenue between the Richmond Parkway and Breuner Marsh. The City plans to move forward with design now so this section can be built at the same time as the 1.5-mile Bay Trail segment at Breuner Marsh in 2015. Completing this gap will extend uninterrupted continuous trail to 12 miles between Pt. Pinole Regional Shoreline to the Albany Bulb. The Committee discussed the proposed surface, width and setback from the road. There was also discussion about matching funds (\$7,000 in-kind from the City of Richmond; \$5,000 from East Bay Regional Park District; and \$2,000 from TRAC) and an interest in seeing increased leverage of our grant program dollars.

ACTION:

Huening moved, LaClair seconded the motion to award a grant to the City of Richmond in the amount of \$63,000 to complete design and construction plans for 0.4 miles of Bay Trail along Goodrick Avenue between Richmond Parkway and Breuner Marsh in Richmond. The vote was approved unanimously.
