The proposed project is located in an unincorporated portion of Alameda County in the Sunol Valley. The entire project site occurs on SFPUC managed land and is contained within the SFPUC's Alameda watershed. The nearest community is the Town of Sunol, located 4.8 miles north of the project site.

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The San Francisco Public Utilities Commission (SFPUC) proposes the New Irvington Tunnel project. The project would be approx 3.5 miles long, extending west from a new Alameda West Portal on the west side of the Sunol Valley to a new Irvington Portal in the City of Fremont. Construction would occur at four work areas. Alameda West Portal (in Sunol Valley), Sheridan Valley (along Sheridan Road), Vargas (along Vargas Road adjacent to I-680) and the Irvington Portal (along Mission Blvd in Fremont).

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The Proposed Project includes construction of (or provides financing for construction of) a series of traffic and infrastructure improvements designed to reduce the amount of automobile traffic originating from Parkmerced, and to improve traffic flow on adjacent roadways such as 19th Avenue and Brotherhood Way. The project also includes a plan to landscape the median area of Junipero Serra Boulevard between 19th Avenue and Brotherhood Way and a section of 19th Ave. that are currently occupied by the Muni rail tracks after the proposed realignment is completed. Other proposed infrastructure improvements include the installation of a variety of new facilities intended to reduce the proposed project's per-unit use of electricity, natural gas, water, and the city's wastewater conveyance and treatment systems.

As this condition worsens, buses may be put out of service and/or passengers may ride for free when they are unable to place money in jammed fareboxes, while the maintenance department seeks parts for repairs.
