Training Course	Target Audience	Course Description
2019 Energy Code Changes- Residential	All building department staff	This course will provide an overview of the 2019 residential Energy Code changes.
Residential Additions	Plan checkers, field inspectors	This course will explore specific instruction on residential additions.
Residential Alterations	Permit technicians, plan checkers, field inspectors	This course will explain how to process residential alterations projects, which are mostly over-the-counter permits such as HVAC changeouts, window replacements and water heater replacements.
Residential Envelope	Plan checkers, field inspectors	This course will investigate residential envelope compliance issues.
Residential New Construction	Permit technicians, plan checkers, field inspectors	This course will provide a basic review of residential new construction energy codes.
Home Energy Rating System (HERS) Registry	Permit technicians, plan checkers, field inspectors	This course will explore the advantages of using the online HERS registry to track and verify compliance forms electronically.
2019 Energy Code Changes- Nonresidential	All building department staff	This course will provide an overview of the 2019 nonresidential Energy Code changes.
Nonresidential New Construction	Permit technicians, plan checkers, field inspectors	This course will provide a basic review of nonresidential new construction energy codes.
Nonresidential Tenant Improvements and Alterations	Plan checkers, field inspectors	This course will explore nonresidential tenant improvements and alterations compliance issues.
Nonresidential Lighting	Plan checkers, building inspectors, building officials	This course will explore lighting compliance and their implications for plan review and field inspection.
Heat Pump Water Heaters	Permit technicians, plan checkers, and field inspectors	This course will describe HPWHs, when HPWHs are allowed under the 2019 Code, code requirements for installation, and how to complete compliance forms.
Reach Codes	Building department, sustainability department, and planning department staff	This course will help attendees understand and better enforce adopted reach codes within a specific jurisdiction. The course includes a combination of general practices as well as customized training for the jurisdiction's reach code.
Zero Net Energy: Residential New Construction	Building department, sustainability department, and planning department staff	This course will introduce ZNE fundamentals and practices that are the basis of ZNE projects.
