- 4. On a Technical Assistance Program Page, Explore Similar Content


Option 1: Use the Search Box

- If you know the name of the content you need, or have a keyword in mind, use the Search Box.




Option 3: Filter by Topic, Program, and/or Type

Important Tip: Combine Filters for a narrowed-down search.


- Combine two or three Filters for more specific results.
 - For example, to see all of the available grants for parking: Under the Program tab, choose "Parking" and under the Type tab, choose "Government Assistance/Grant." This will show you all of the results for "Parking" AND for "Government Assistance/Grant."
- Or choose only one Filter for broader search results.
 - For example, to see all available grants, under the Type tab, choose
 "Government Assistant/Grant," and your results will display ALL grants available in the Technical Assistance Portal.
