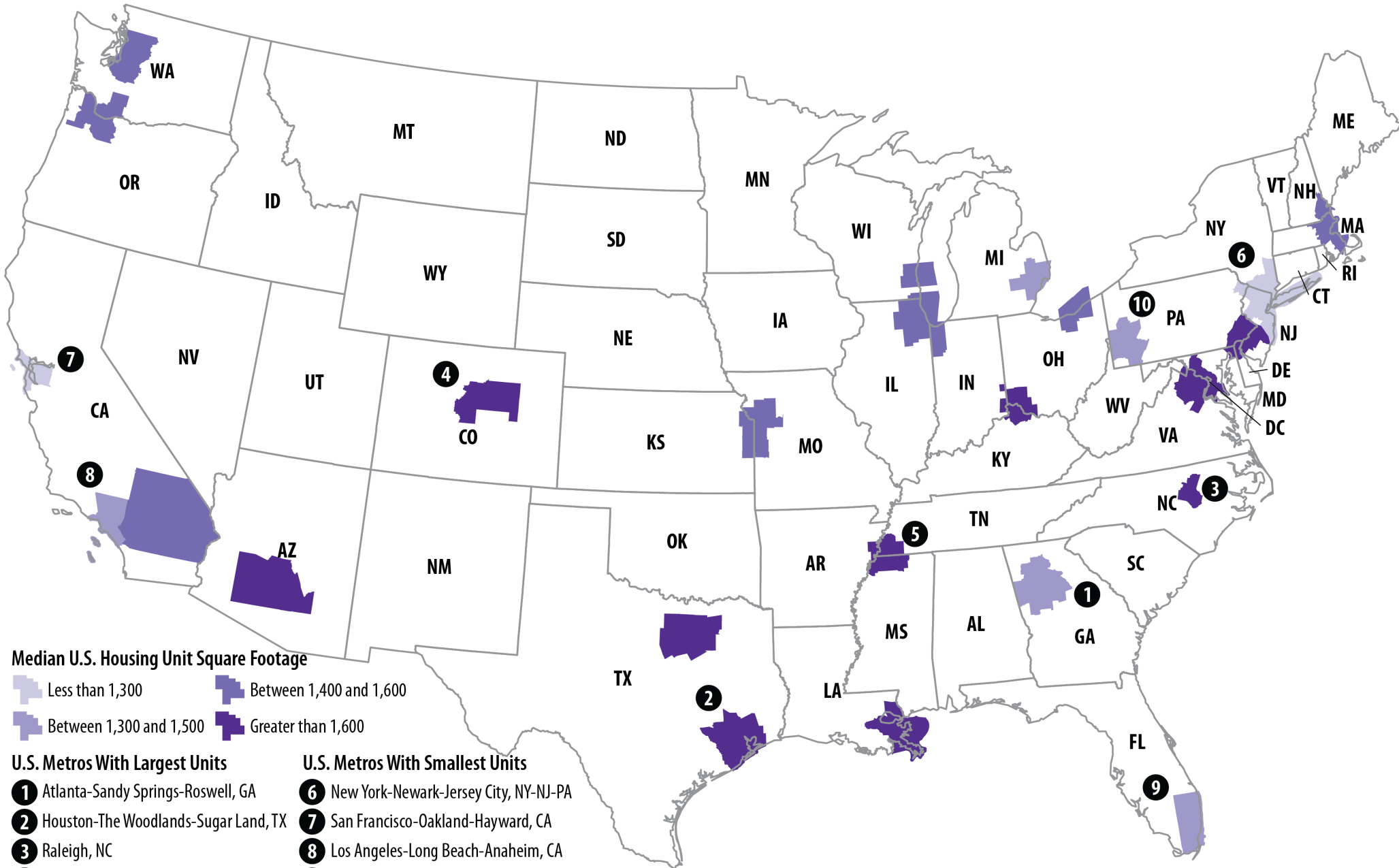




Median Square Footage of Housing Units in Major U.S. Metro Areas
