Randy Rentschler, MTC Legislation and Public Affairs Director, presented initial ideas for state and federal legislative priorities for 2018. He spoke on transportation issues, including Senate Bill 1, Cap and Trade, Regional Measure 3, and disadvantaged communities.

Georgia Gann Dohrmann, MTC Governmental Relations Associate Manager, reported on housing supply and affordability, including CASA implementation, housing funding; incentivizing production, reforming state housing laws, housing construction costs, and emergency relief measures; energy and water efficiency; resilience; high-occupancy vehicles; bus service; automated speed enforcement; shared mobility; autonomous vehicles; and transportation project delivery.

Members discussed high-occupancy vehicle lane enforcement; disability issues related to state housing law reform; CASA implementation and local authority; the North Bay Wild Fires and toll lanes; connected and autonomous vehicles deployment; Cap and Trade and air quality; state housing law reform and energy efficiency.

Gann Dohrmann reported on federal transportation and housing funding, infrastructure initiative, and tax reform.
